Co-Owner General Cleaning Guidelines - Per CDC Recommendations

Due to the limited usage (less than 10% of co-owners) of the bathroom facilities during the off-season (when water and sewer services are not available to co-owners), co-owners are required to clean the bath area after their use. Disinfection of the area will occur on the dates and times posted. All co-owners using the facility must sign and complete the Mandatory Facility Usage log. **Any co-owner using the bath facility is doing so at his/her own risk.**

1. It is required that co-owners bring hand sanitizer when entering the building. Upon entering and before completing the Mandatory Usage Log, use hand sanitizer. Use enough sanitizer (about the size of a dime) to rub on the top and bottom of your hands and in between your fingers. Let DRY before completing the log.
2. It is recommend that co-owners wipe down areas **before** use with the cleaner provided.
3. **Co-owners are required to clean all areas that were used:** toilets including base, handles, toilet paper dispenser, shower stalls and handles, sinks including fixtures, counter tops, entry door handles both coming and going, etc with the cleaner provided.
 1. Shower stalls, including hand rails, curtains, seating area, etc should be sprayed thoroughly with cleaner and left, no need to rinse. Ensure that shower curtains are fully open to allow for thorough drying.
 2. Toilets and sinks, fixtures, counter tops, door handles, soap dispenser, towel dispenser etc should be thoroughly saturated with the cleaner and then wiped with the towels provided. All towels should be disposed of in the trash container.
 3. After cleaning used areas, wash hands thoroughly with soap and water.
 4. Prior to leaving the facility, ensure that the Mandatory Usage Log has been completed in its entirety and all paper products have been placed in the trash, the cleaning bottle has been placed back and the area has been thoroughly cleaned.
